HCF in the Community Highlights

DR. BOWER HEALTHCARE CENTER:

Held a fundraiser, Taste of Henderson, in coordination with the Henderson Chamber of Commerce in April, raising \$6,000 and held the La Buda Golf Classic this fall raising \$10,000.

LINDSAY BENNETT MEMORIAL:

The first Lindsay Bennett Memorial Scholarship at UNLV was awarded this past spring. The fourth "Follow Your Bliss" Scholarship was awarded to a Coronado HS senior.

APPLE PARTNERSHIP:

The annual Celebration of Reading event winners were awarded checks for \$7,000, \$1,000 and \$500: Vanderberg ES average of 64.88 hours per student, Dooley ES with 62.07 hours, and Twitchell ES with 45.95 hours.

SM@RTCONNECTIONS:

This year, we welcomed a new fund that is providing critical education to parents and students on living in a cyber-connected world (i.e. Internet safety, sex-tortion: aka sexting extortion, etc.).

KEEP THE MUSIC ALIVE:

On May 29th the fund volunteers presented 36 new instruments costing \$14,200, and another 20 gently-used instruments, estimated to cost \$10,000, to Brown JHS' band program.
